The cruise is scheduled to depart at 4:30 pm (Boarding begins at 4:15) on Sunday 15 October 2017 from 85 Woodcleft Avenue Freeport NY. (Bring your own meals, snack and non-alcoholic beverages). Dress warmly and bring binoculars if you have them.

USPS District 3 will provide charts so you can follow the buoy system. The timing of the cruise has been planned so that we will have a minimum of an hour of cruising during daylight followed by a minimum of an hour cruising during twilight, when the navigational light characteristics can be seen.
